

Sam Greenlee, 11/29/22: I wanted to share a few resources with you all that may prove helpful. As we've been doing our policy work, we have found the tools for California's new Senate and Assembly districts to be quite limited and so had to develop our own mapping resources. Now that we have the tools, I'd like to share them:

1. If you are interested in creating your own custom map that includes legislative districts, you can [download the KML files at this link](#) and then upload them into your own custom Google MyMap. The Google tool limits upload size to 5MB so I had to break the Assembly into three files and the Senate into two. Once you upload them into your map, you can turn the layers on or off as you see fit. There are decent tutorials for all of this, but if you need to build a custom map with these, please let me know and I will be happy to provide some direction if I have the capacity.
2. If you just need a map with the Senate and Assembly districts and don't want to build your own, [you can use this](#).
